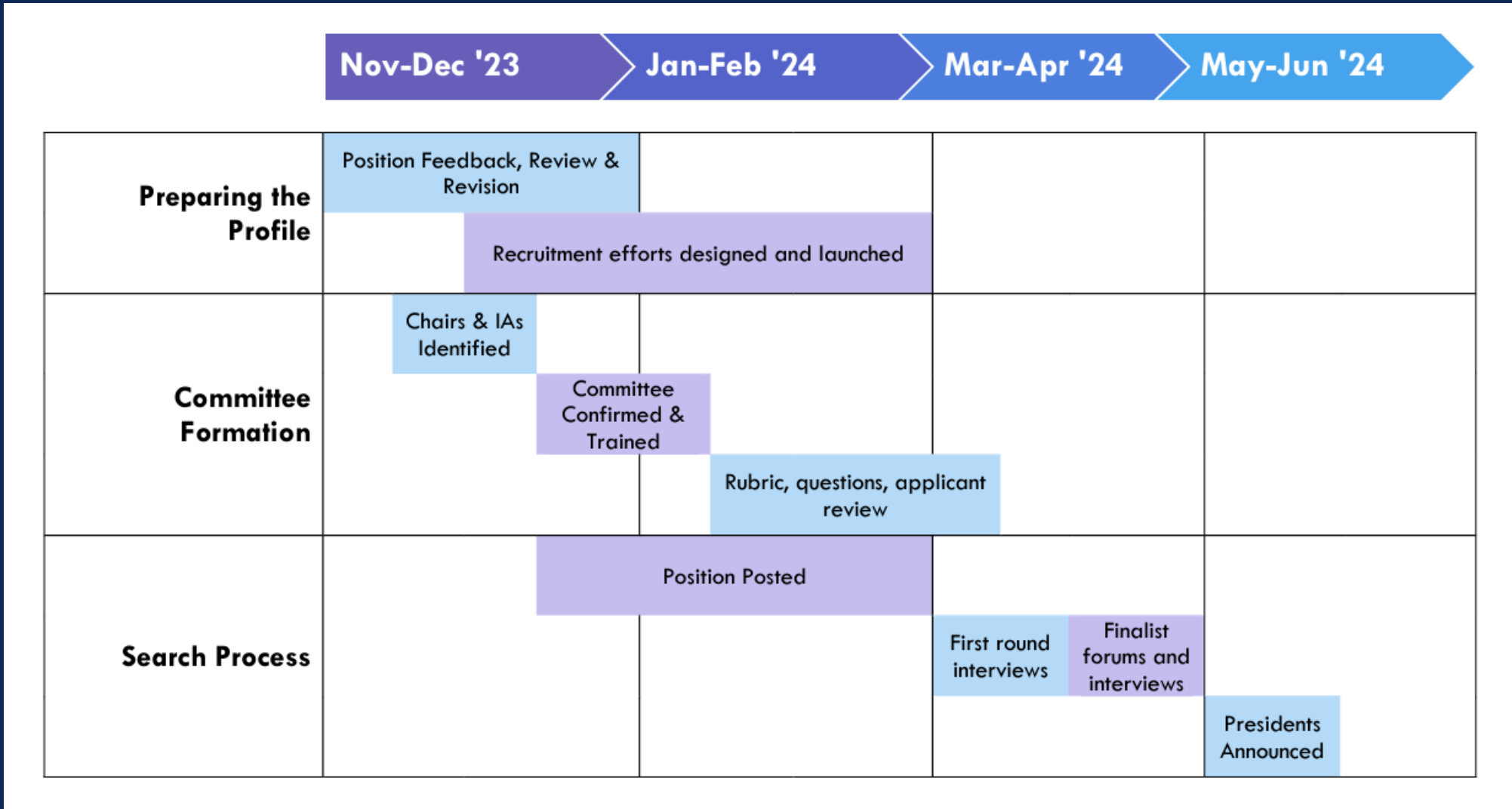

THE PLAN

Conduct 3 simultaneous presidential searches:

- 3 Search committees: North, Central and South
- District-wide Logistics Work Team: supports/coordinates logistics and planning; Inclusion Advocate support, HR support; staff support

ELEMENTS OF THE SEARCHES

Revisiting the President Role

- Campus-wide open review period of previous job descriptions, online feedback form
- President panel to share how the roles have evolved (Dec 5th, 3:30 pm, Zoom)

College representative search committees

- Search committee including (not limited to) union, student, EDIC and community representation
- Inclusion Advocate support, staff support
- Specialized search committee training

District-wide logistic support & planning

- Specialized search committee training
- Planning support for committees
- Coordinate second round logistics
- Anticipatory planning for the complexities of the search
